The Institution of Engineers (India), Kerala State Centre celebrated Gandhi Jayanthi on October 2,2017 at Visvesvaraya Bhavan, Thiruvananthapuram. True to the teachings of the Father of our Nation, the celebration kicked off with cleaning of the premises of

IEI KSC by the Corporate Members and Staff. This cleaning on Swachh Bharat Diwas was in tune with the call of our Prime Minister, Sri Narendra Modi that "Swachhata has to become Swabhav – it is our collective responsibility to keep our Nation clean."

Later, there was a talk on the topic, 'Gandhiyan Chinthakalum – Adivasi Oorukalum' by Mr. T.Madhava Menon IAS (Retd) and Former Vice Chancellor, Kerala Agricultural University.

Er.K.S.Udaya Kumar, Hon. Secretary, IEI KSC who welcomed the gathering opined that Mr. Menon was the oldest retired IAS Officer in Kerala, still as active as ever. Er.N.Rajkumar, Chairman, IEI KSC, who presided over the function remarked that Mr. Menon is an expert in the knowledge on Adivasis.

According to Mr. Menon, the degree of exploitation of Adivasis is much more than their degree of poverty. He made it clear that the procedures of Government Departments should not stand in the way of completion of projects beneficial to society. Also the system of awarding public works to Contractors has to be ended. The Contractors and the society are the two ends with Govt. Departments in between. This creates a lot of problems with the society suffering the most with low quality of completed projects. Instead now there is a system avoiding the Contractors with direct execution of works by Departments. It is also necessary to have Technical Audit of projects. For the improvement of Adivasis, the elected Panchayat should be given more powers in implementing developmental projects rather than giving powers to bureaucracy. He concluded by saying that rules and regulations are remaining in paper as far as Kerala is concerned. Unless they are put into practice, the future of Panchayati Raj seems bleak for the development of Adivasis.

WORLD HABITAT DAY

The Institution of Engineers (India), Kerala State Centre observed World Habitat Day on October 2, 2017 at Visvesvaraya Bhavan, Thiruvananthapuram. Er.P.A.Prabhakaran, Chief Engineer (Retd.), ISRO and Advisor to Chairman, ISRO, Dept. of Space, Govt. of India, delivered the talk on the theme, 'Housing Policies; - Affordable Homes'. Earlier, Er.K.S.Udaya Kumar, Hon. Secretary, IEI KSC welcomed the gathering and introduced the speaker.

According to Er.Prabhakaran, the Central Govt. aims at providing 50 million homes by 2025. He made it clear that Engineers have to bring out results by completing projects in time keeping in view escalation of the cost of labour
